Methodology: The sample size for the survey is 508 active voters in Texas. 308 interviews were collected using automated telephone technology and 200 were collected using mobile-app based technology. The margin of error is +/- 4.4 %. Interviews were conducted September 16-18, 2018 by PopPolling Research. Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
