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**Methodology:** The sample size for the survey is 696 active voters in Florida. 443 interviews were collected using automated telephone technology and 253 were collected using mobile-app based technology. The margin of error is +/- 3.7 %. Interviews were conducted October 27-30, 2018 by PopPolling Research. Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
