**Methodology:** The sample size for the survey is 702 active voters in Arizona. 300 interviews were collected using automated telephone technology, 201 online and 201 were collected using mobile-app based technology. The margin of error is +/- 3.5 %. Interviews were conducted September 29-October 1, 2018 by PopPolling Research. Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
