Methodology: The sample size for the survey is 794 active voters in New Jersey. 543 interviews were collected online and 251 were collected using mobile-app based technology. The margin of error is +/- 3.5 %. Interviews were conducted September 29-October 1, 2018 by PopPolling Research. Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
